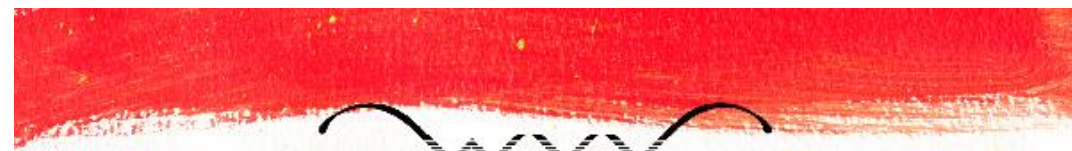
Sponsor a singer

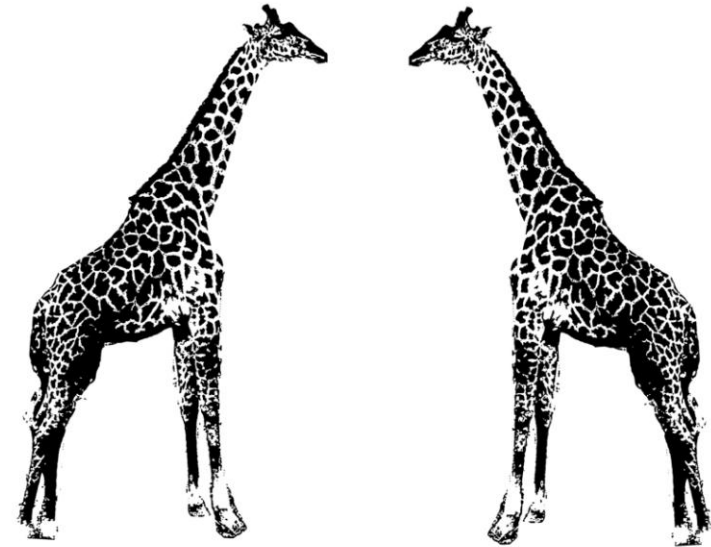
